The Regular Meeting of the Board of Health of the Borough of Moonachie is called to order by President M. Cinque in the Kathryn E. Flynn Civic Center on February 8, 2016 at 7:51pm.

M. Cinque called for the Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag.

Report from Health Inspector Maria Schmitt:

Mobile trucks are coming for inspections, only a few left. Inspected Prova and Movado. No animal bites in January. There were complaints from both mobile home communities about maintenance, garbage, dumpsters. Spoke about responding to all complaints.

M. Cinque – had a question about peddler license procedure in the minutes from the last meeting. Maria stated that for peddler, they fill out applications, the Police Department does a check, then she schedules an inspection for the license. Waiting for some grease trap inspections for retail food licenses.

OLD BUSINESS:

C/Millar – mentioned that she brought up at the Mayor and Council meeting the recommendation for changing the prices for the dog licenses. They would consider a recommendation from the Board of Health.

Board discussed prices for the licenses, how much the increase should be-\$12/15, or \$13/16.
Spoke about when the last price changes were made.

If prices are raised, make sure there is notice in the Messenger for residents to be aware, put it in the summer months and again for the end of the year.

MOONACHIE, IN THE COUNTY OF BERGEN, NEW JERSEY,
REGARDING PUBLIC RECREATIONAL BATHING
